INCLEMENT WEATHER CLOSURES & MEETING CANCELLATIONS

Due to the forecasted inclement weather, the Community Center at the Fellowship House will close at 6:00 PM this evening. The Dog Park Advisory Committee scheduled for tonight at 6:30 PM will also be canceled. In addition, the Borough Administrative Office and the Community Center at the Fellowship House will be closed, and the Borough Council public meeting will be canceled tomorrow, Wednesday, March 21, 2018. Yard waste and bulk trash collection will also be canceled this Wednesday so that Public Works can focus all attention on clearing snow from the streets.

The Borough Council public meeting will be rescheduled for Thursday, March 22, 2018 at 7:00 PM at Borough Hall. The next scheduled Dog Park Advisory Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at 6:30 PM at Borough Hall.

This is a reminder that the Mayor has declared a snow emergency beginning midnight, March 21, 2018 and lasting until further notice. During the snow emergency parking is restricted on the following streets: Fayette Street, both sides from the Conshohocken Borough line to the bridge; all metered areas, the south side of Freedly Street from 12th to 11th Avenues, Poplar Street from Elm Street to Washington Street. Vehicles parked on these snow emergency routes may be towed.

Snow Removal Reminders for Residents:

- Cones, lawn chairs or any other property or device are not to be used to hold or reserve parking spaces during the storm. The Borough street crew will not stop to remove any property or device used to reserve a space.
- Per the Borough of Conshohocken Code, the property owner is responsible for removing all snow and/or ice from his or her sidewalks. The pathway should be at least 36 inches in width along the entire length of the sidewalk and shall be removed within 24 hours after snow has ceased to fall, or the ice to form.
- When removing snow or ice from public sidewalks, no person may shovel, throw, plow or otherwise move snow or ice into the public street.
- No person may move snow and ice from the public street in front of his or her property to another portion of public street fronting another property.
