**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC*; PROVIDING FOR UPDATE AND AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 15 TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN PARKING SPACES AND/OR PARKING AREAS AS NO PARKING, MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE PARKING, SPECIAL PURPOSE PARKING, OR HANDICAPPED PARKING ONLY; REPEALING PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND CONTAINING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Borough Code to enact certain regulations relating to the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the community of the Borough of Conshohocken; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and the Borough Code to enact certain regulations concerning the movement of vehicles and traffic in and through the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken has established, *inter alia*, regulations relating to the parking of vehicles within the Borough of Conshohocken at Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* of the Code of the Borough of Conshohocken; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken desires to amend Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* to designate additional parking spaces and/or parking areas as no parking, municipal employee parking, special purpose parking, or handicapped parking only.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken as follows:

**SECTION 1**

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, § 15-402 *Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations* is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Between</b>
Walnut Street	Both	from the northern intersection with East Hector Street north to “no parking” signage and from the southern intersection with East Hector Street south to “no parking” signage

**SECTION 2**

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, § 15-406 *Special Purpose Parking Zones Established; Parking Otherwise Prohibited* is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>	<b>Authorized Purpose of Vehicle</b>
East Elm	Both	Between Jones Street and Walnut Street	Municipal employee parking (16 spaces)
East 6th	South	Between Harry Street and Hallowell Street (Community Center)	Municipal employee parking (2 spaces)
Forrest Street	Both	Between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue	Red zone parking permit

**SECTION 3**

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, § 15-702 *Reserved Parking for Handicapped May be Provided* is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

**§ 15-702. Reserved Spaces for Handicapped May be Provided.**

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>	<b>Purpose</b>
Hallowell Street	West	Between 5th Avenue and Sixth Avenue (Mary H. Wood Park)	Handicapped Parking (2 spaces)

**SECTION 4**

Any and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in violation or in conflict with the terms, conditions and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such irreconcilable conflict.

**SECTION 5**

The terms, conditions and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and, should any portion, part or provision of this Ordinance be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, non-enforceable or unconstitutional, the Council hereby declares its intent that the Ordinance shall have been enacted without regard to the invalid, non-enforceable, or unconstitutional portion, part or provision of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
