CALL TO ORDER

The Public Meeting of the Conshohocken Borough Council duly advertised, was held at the Conshohocken Borough Hall, 400 Fayette Street, Conshohocken, PA. Ms. Colleen Leonard, Borough Council President, called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

INTRODUCTION

Mr. Sokolowski provided an overview of the meeting agenda. He reviewed the Borough's current budget deficit and estimated Fund Balance for the General Fund going into fiscal year 2019. Mr. Sokolowski discussed the fund sources available for capital consideration in 2019. He also briefly discussed alternative funding options for the future.

DEPARTMENTAL CAPITAL BUDGET REQUEST PRESENTATIONS

a.) Fire Department

Tim Gunning, Fire Chief, presented the capital budget requests for the Fire Department, which included a utility vehicle. Mr. Gunning explained a utility vehicle would allow for access to small areas, which a large fire truck would not otherwise be able to access.

b.) Emergency Services

Robert Zinni, Fire Marshal, presented the capital budget requests for Emergency Services, which included a Panasonic Toughbook. Mr. Zinni explained that the laptop would be used from emergency management coordination with the County and other emergency services personnel.

c.) Recreation Services

Lauren Irizarry, Director of Recreation Services, presented the capital budget requests for the Recreation Department, which included various aesthetic improvements and security enhancements to the Community Center and commercial-grade trashcans for Borough Parks.

d.) Community Development and Zoning

Chris Stetler, Community Development Coordinator and Zoning Officer, presented the capital budget requests for Community Development and Zoning, which included funds for grant matching and FEMA requirements.

e.) Police Department

George Metz, Acting Chief of Police, presented capital budget requests for the Police Department, which included communication devices, replacement vehicles and active shooter response equipment.

f.) Public Services and Licenses & Inspections

Mr. Sokolowski presented the capital budget requests for the Public Services Department, which included a security gate at the Public Services Garage, a dump truck and Toter 64-gallon roll cart trash and recycle carts for the residents of the Borough.

Council discussed and determined which departmental capital requests presented will be considered for fiscal year 2019. Mr. Sokolowski reviewed the recurring capital expenditures.
