ORDINANCE NO. _____ 2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CONSHOHOCKEN *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC*; PROVIDING FOR UPDATE AND AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 15 TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN PARKING SPACES AND/OR PARKING AREAS AS 2-HOUR PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS; REPEALING PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND CONTAINING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Borough Code to enact certain regulations relating to the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the community of the Borough of Conshohocken; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken is duly empowered by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and the Borough Code to enact certain regulations concerning the movement of vehicles and traffic in and through the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken has established, *inter alia*, regulations relating to the parking of vehicles within the Borough of Conshohocken at Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* of the Code of the Borough of Conshohocken; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken desires to amend Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic* to establish a two-hour limitation on parking within a certain area of Maple Street in the Borough during certain hours as set forth below, unless a residential parking permit is displayed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Conshohocken as follows:

SECTION 1

Chapter 15 *Vehicles and Traffic*, § 15-405 *Parking Time Limited in Certain Locations, Certain Days and Hours* to include the following new provisions:

Street	Side	Between	Days	Time Limit	Hours
Maple Street	Both	West Elm Street and 3rd Avenue	M-Sun	2 hours unless a Borough-issued residential parking permit is displayed	6 am-6 pm

SECTION 2

Any and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in violation or in conflict with the terms, conditions and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such irreconcilable conflict.

SECTION 3

The terms, conditions and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and, should any portion, part or provision of this Ordinance be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, non-enforceable or unconstitutional, the Council hereby declares its intent that the Ordinance shall have been enacted without regard to the invalid, non-enforceable, or unconstitutional portion, part or provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
