# Floodplain Grading, Excavation, and Demolition Permit Application

#### SECTION 1: GENERAL PROVISIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The Applicant is to provide two (2) copies of this application.
- 2. No work is to start until a permit is issued.
- 3. The permit may be revoked at any time, if false statements are made herein; and if revoked all work is to cease until a permit is re-issued.
- 4. The Applicant is hereby informed that other permits may be required to fulfill other state and federal requirements. The Applicant is to provide copies of all such permits to the Borough of Conshohocken.
- 5. The Applicant hereby gives consent to the Flood Plain Administrator and to representatives of the Conshohocken Department of Engineering, Licenses and Inspections Department or their representatives to make reasonable inspections to verify compliance.
- 6. The application shall be accompanied by a site plan showing the limit of the one percent (1%) annual flood limit; the elevation of any structure to be removed; the elevation of any grading change; and if applicable the type, amount, and top elevation of any fill to be added to the site.
- 7. The Borough reserves the right to require hydrological and hydraulic studies and/or any other information necessary to determine compliance with the Zoning Ordinance Flood Plain Conservation District.
- 8. The Applicant is advised that this permit, if issued, does cover the construction of any structures in or adjacent to any flood plain and a separate Floodplain Development Permit is required.
