# **DO NOT RECYCLE**

- No garbage
- No pizza boxes
- No food/ liquids
- No used paper plates, paper towels, or paper napkins
- No food tainted items
- No ice cream cartons
- No clothing/ shoes
- No polystyrene
- No light bulbs
- No yard waste
- No Styrofoam
- No hazardous waste: needles, diapers, chemicals, chemical containers, or motor oil bottles
- No bulk items: wood, furniture, scrap metal, propane tanks, plastic toys, sporting goods, or tools
